

Tips for Safe Use of Microwave Ovens

Dear Residents,

To prevent any possible risks from using the Microwave Oven in the Halls, we would like to share with you the following quick tips:

Do's

- Use Microwave-safe Containers.
- Choose appropriate Heating Time for reheating food.
- Clean up any messes or spills after use.

Don'ts

- Do Not leave your food unattended.
- Do Not place any combustible object near the microwave oven.
- Do Not let water splash on the hot viewing glass since it may cause glass cracking and danger.
- Do Not place sealed containers or use any items with metal elements in a microwave oven, it may cause explosion and catch fire.
- Do Not **overcook** food as it can create a fire hazard.
- Do Not reheat **non-microwaveable** food (e.g. eggs) as this may result in explosion.
