

The Better Working World Data Challenge

An annual global data science challenge for university students and young professionals, using data and artificial intelligence to find tangible solutions to real-world problems, and help build a better world.

In close partnership with Microsoft, the challenge provides students free access to Azure and IT certifications.

Training sessions from technologists at EY and Microsoft will help participants develop additional skills and refine their work.

Two challenges of different difficulties will cater to all levels of knowledge and experience.

Winners will be announced at a global virtual awards ceremony, with cash prizes of up to US\$10,000*. The top 60 global finalists will also win the opportunity to access EY mentoring.

IP will be available free of charge for non-commercial use – which means the program will bring real change and impact.
