



# Cyberport University Partnership Programme (CUPP) Overview



## Programme Overview

CUPP is a **FinTech** focused entrepreneurship programme with boot camp, mentorship and competition that aiming at nurturing young FinTech talents for Hong Kong since 2015.

## Programme Structure

- **CUPP 2023 Co-organising Universities\*** are invited to nominate teams of current students and recent graduates aged **between 18 to 30 years old**. Each team shall consist 3 to 5 team members.
- The nominated teams will be assessed by written test and interview. Up to 20 teams will be selected to join a series of FinTech pre-camp nurturing sessions and industry mentorship in Hong Kong and 7-day Entrepreneurship Boot Camp at **University of Cambridge** in July 2023.
- After the Boot Camp, the teams will pitch to a judging panel in Hong Kong. The winning teams could **win HK\$100,000 Cyberport Creative Micro Fund** to continue their start-up venture.

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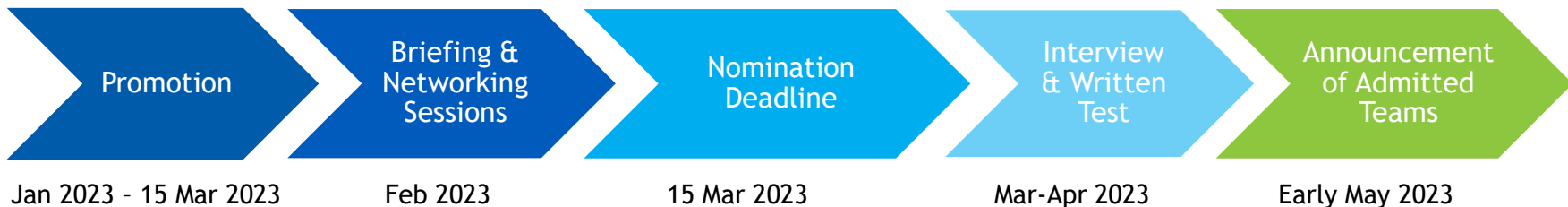
## Programme Offers

- A series of FinTech pre-camp nurturing sessions in Hong Kong, including the latest FinTech applications sharing, financial regulation and team building activities.
- Entrepreneurship Boot Camp at University of Cambridge, including campus tour, on-campus lectures, case studies, group work, industry guest speakers' sessions and networking, one-on-one mentoring, company visits and cultural explore.
- Valuable mentorship and insight from FinTech experts, both locally and globally.
- Pitch innovative FinTech business idea to a panel of judges.
- Win HK\$100,000 grant by Cyberport Creative Micro Fund.

# Eligibility for CUPP 2023



- Project must be **rooted in digital tech** and focus on **FinTech** related with components, Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain and Cybersecurity etc.
- Applicants must be nominated by CUPP 2023 Co-organising Universities.
- Applicants must be **between 18 to 30 years old (inclusive)** upon the nomination deadline (i.e. 15 March 2023).
- Applicants must be undergraduate or postgraduate students nominated by the Co-organising Universities, either currently enrolled university students or recently graduated within 3 years (i.e 15 March 2020 to 15 March 2023) from the co-organising universities.
- Applicants must have good command of English.
- Team members could be a mixture of students from the CUPP 2023 Co-organising Universities.
- Each team could have **up to 5 members**. Suggested team structure:
  - 1 Team Leader (i.e. principal applicant) with Hong Kong ID Card holder
  - Up to 2 Core Team Members with technical/UIUX/FinTech knowledge, who will be joining Entrepreneurship Boot Camp;
  - Up to 2 Supporting Team Members, who will **NOT** be joining Entrepreneurship Boot Camp
  - Maximum 3 members per team can join the Entrepreneurship Boot Camp.

# Admission Fee and Deposit

(paid upon successful admission to CUPP 2023 – Stage 2)



## Admission Fee

Individuals are required to pay a **non-refundable HK\$1,000 Admission Fee**.  
(HKMA FCAS students / alumni are eligible to waive admission fee)

## Deposit

A refundable deposit will be collected from Individuals admitted CUPP 2023. The deposit is refundable upon full attendance and performance of the participants in CUPP 2023, as assessed by Cyberport.

**HK\$6,000 deposit for individuals joining the Overseas Entrepreneurship Boot Camp; or  
HK\$3,000 deposit for individuals NOT joining the Entrepreneurship Boot Camp.**

## Notes

- The admission fee covers CUPP administrative costs, and all the fee collected would be used for Cyberport public mission startup training programmes.
- Students successfully admitted to CUPP will join CUPP 2023 with 100% subsidized by Cyberport for pre-camp nurturing sessions in Hong Kong and Entrepreneurship Boot Camp at University of Cambridge, including training fee, local accommodation, round-trip economy flight tickets and meals.
- Students are required to join all activities throughout the programme. Cyberport reserved the right to request students did not participate CUPP Demo Day, to pay back the expenses incurred for their attendance in the CUPP 2023.

# How to apply for CUPP?

CUPP is a programme on nomination-based. Interested applicants should contact **CUPP 2023 Co-organising Universities** for nomination details. Nominated teams should provide their academic performance, award received, entrepreneurial experience and proposed FinTech project to the universities for consideration.

Written test and interview will be arranged after the nomination deadline. Written test will be reviewed by Cambridge and teams will pitch their FinTech business idea to judging panel for interview. Selected students will be notified by email from Cyberport.

# Interview & Written Test (Stage 1)



## Interview

- Nominated teams will be invited to do interview at Cyberport
- Teams are required to prepare 5 mins pitch to present the FinTech project idea, follow by 10 mins Q&A from judges
- The Interview will be conducted in English
- Full team attendance is required
- Judging Criteria including, project idea, attitude, communications, entrepreneurial aspiration, knowledge of FinTech/ Finance/ Technologies

## Written Test

- Written test will be prepared and reviewed by University of Cambridge

# Demo Day - Judging Criteria (Stage 2)

## Project Management Team (30%)

The capability of the project management team is evaluated according to track record, execution ability, probability of launch, individual qualifications and roles within the team.

## Business Model and Time to Market (30%)

The business model is evaluated by the short and long term objectives, apparent market need, target market and marketing strategy, and realistic assessment of the project viability. Projects that launch within three months of grant disbursement are preferred.

## Creativity and Innovation of the Proposed Project, Product and Service (30%)

Innovative technology, creative solutions, disruptive ideas, emerging technology and breakthrough problem-solving will score higher.

## Social Responsibility (10%)

Preference will be given to projects with socially responsible dimensions, such as open source software, creative commons IP, ethical decision making, or which contribute to solving social problems.
