






Cyberport Entrepreneurship Programmes

Through a bracket of targeted incubation programmes, Cyberport caters specifically to priority needs for entrepreneurship in different development stages, ranging from talent training, seed funding, go-to-market assistance to investor matching:

HK\$100,000 grant to support innovative ideas and early-stage start-ups development over a 6-months project period to become venture and move forward to incubation

Eligibility - Two Streams for Applicants

Professional Programme

Open to applicants aged 18 or above upon application deadline

Individual Applicants: Principal applicant must be Hong Kong ID Card holder


Company Applicants: Limited company registered and incorporated in Hong Kong upon admission

Hong Kong Young Entrepreneur Programme

Individual Applicants: Principal applicant must be **Hong Kong ID Card holder** and all members in the project management team must be aged 18-30.

Company Applicants: Limited company registered and incorporated in Hong Kong upon admission and all company owners and team members must be aged 18-30.

Up to **HK\$500,000** and **HK\$200,000** on-site rental subsidy, financial assistance, professional advice and strong networks to accelerate your business growth over 24 months

Eligibility

- A registered digital tech company limited by shares and incorporated in Hong Kong less than 7
 years (or in progress of incorporation) upon application deadline
- A viable business plan with product / solution ready for marketing in 12-18 months
- · Founders collectively must hold at least 51% of the company shares or have absolute control
- All Incubatees shall maintain local presence with at least one local authorised representative
 physically working in Hong Kong (mainly to support local operation and product development)
 in the incubation period. Such a representative shall be either a Founder/Co-founder or a local
 full-time staff employed by the Incubatee

The Cyberport Accelerator Support Programme prepares Cyberport incubatees, grantees and alumni for international markets and investors, providing up to **HK\$300,000** financial assistance to each successful applicant.

The Cyberport Accelerator Support Programme offers the following financial assistance



75% subsidy on accelerator programme fees



75% subsidy on office rental



50% subsidy for interns



subsidy on travel and accommodation



subsidy on marketing and promotion (up to HK\$50,000)



75% on professional services

Application Criteria

- · Cyberport incubatees, CCMF grantees or alumni
- Admitted to accelerator programmes endorsed by Cyberport

Market **D**evelopment **S**upport **S**cheme



The Market Development Support Scheme (MDSS) reimburses Cyberport incubatees, grantees and alumni up to **HK\$200,000** for expenses* to expand their businesses to the Mainland and Overseas markets.

Four scopes of Market Development Activities for Overseas/ Mainland Markets are covered:

- Delegation mission to Overseas/ Mainland
- Marketing exhibition/ conference/ event
- Landing service for Overseas/ Mainland market expansion
- Online/ offline marketing services for Overseas/ Mainland market expansion

*The reimbursable percentage is up to 75% of eligible expenses

Eligible reimbursable items include#:

- Programme or exhibition fee
- Training as professional landing service
- Live streaming service

- Placement of online/ offline advertisement service
- Video production service (corporate branding or product promotional videos)
