Dear Sir / Madam,

No Objection Letter
(Re: Student Visa / Entry Permit)

This letter is issued to you as a non-local student who has been admitted into Hong Kong for study in a full-time locally-accredited local programme at undergraduate level or above. The permission for you to remain in Hong Kong will end upon expiry of your limit of stay or four weeks after termination of your studies, whichever is the earlier.

Under Regulation 2(3) of the Immigration Regulations, Cap. 115A, the permission to be given to you to land in Hong Kong as a student shall be subject to the following conditions of stay-

- (a) that you shall become a student only at a specified school, university or other educational institution and undertake such course of study as may be approved by the Director of Immigration; and
- (b) that you shall not-
 - (i) take any employment, whether paid or unpaid; or
 - (ii) establish or join in any business.

Notwithstanding the above, the Director of Immigration has no objection to your taking up employment with effect from the date of issue of this letter throughout the validity of this visa/entry permit on conditions that (1) you remain as a student studying Bachelor of [REDACTED] (Hons.) in [REDACTED] at Hong Kong Baptist University and (2) your limit of stay in Hong Kong remains unexpired.

Please note that the Director of Immigration's stance of no objection to your taking up employment set out in this letter will only apply on the condition that you have a valid permission to remain as a student in Hong Kong for studying Bachelor of [REDACTED] (Hons.) in [REDACTED] at Hong Kong Baptist University. In the event that you switch to another institution and/or study programme, the Director of Immigration's no objection as set out in this letter will not apply and you will be in breach of your condition of stay if you continue to take up any employment unless a new no objection letter has been given by the Immigration Department.

You are reminded that non-local students admitted to take up post-secondary programmes will be imposed with a condition of stay to take up a prescribed course in a prescribed educational institution. Any change in condition of stay requires the prior approval from the Immigration Department.
