General Information of Hall Awards for Outstanding Residents

Purpose

The Hall Awards for Outstanding Residents (Award) recognize and award current residents who have made substantial contributions to the Undergraduate Halls (Halls).

Eligibility

Halls residents fulfilling the following criteria are eligible to apply for the Award:

- Having resided and/or currently residing in Halls in the current residential year; and
- cGPA 2.5 or above is attained at the time of application.

Types of Awards

The Award can be awarded in three ranks, namely A, B and C.

A	\$5,000

С	\$1,500

The actual number of awards will be subject to the decision of the Selection Panel. The total amount of award disbursed by each hall shall not exceed \$28,000.

Attributes Involved / Demonstrated at the Undergraduate Halls

Attribute	Examples of Possible Contributions
Leadership Skills	 Serving in the Halls, in both official and/or unofficial capacities. Serving as the bridge between the Hall Management and/or Resident Master by reflecting residents' views and clearly explaining hall management decisions to fellow residents.
Positive Attitude	 Contributing to the Halls with a positive and constructive attitude. Demonstrating a strong sense of belonging to the Halls.
Participation in Hall Life Education Programmes	 Frequent participation of hall life education activities organised by Resident Master and/or Leadership Qualities Centre. Assisting Resident Master to organise hall life education activities.
Integration of Local and Non-local Students	 Demonstrating respect and appreciation for different cultures. Facilitating the integration of local and non-local residents. Stepping out of comfort zone and get to know students with different cultural backgrounds.
Fostering Personal Growth of Fellow Residents	 Creating positive impact on hall life of fellow residents. Encouraging residents to pursue for improvement of hall life activities.

Residents achieving at least one attributes above are encouraged to apply. Shortlisted applicants would be invited to a Selection Panel chaired by their respective Resident Master for interview.
