## Application Method

Submit your **online** application forms **at least two weeks before the first class** of the proposed programme.

## Amount of the award

The Selection Panel will review and award the CEA programme with reference to the scale:

- Programme Hours from 1.5 hours\* to 4 hours: HK\$ 400 to HK\$ 900
- Programme Hours from 5 hours to 7 hours: HK\$ 1000 to HK\$ 1700
- Programme Hours from 8 hours or more: HK\$ 1800 to HK\$ 2000

\*For programme lasting for 1.5 hours only, it must be conducted in one session within the same day.

## Criteria of Programme

- 1 Include cultural elements.
- 2 Open to all residents.
- 3 Conduct in English except for foreign language learning programmes.
- 4 Minimum class size of 10 local, mainland and international students.
- 5 Conduct in group or individually.
- 6 Design, promote and deliver your own programme.
