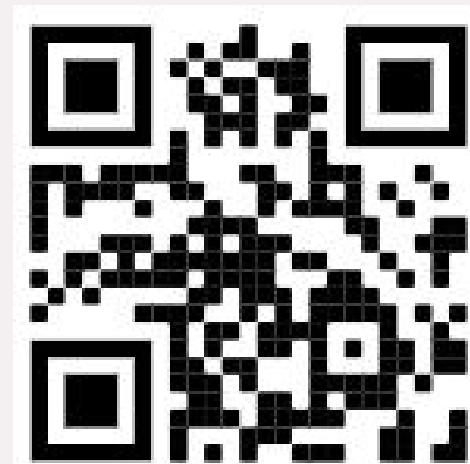


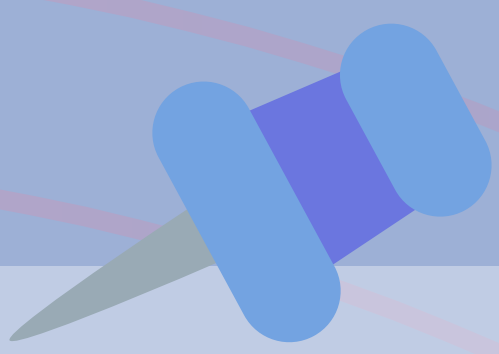

2020 is the fourth year of the programme!

This year, we have recruited 100 student volunteers and 50 elderly buddies living in Lok Fu and Wong Tai Sin.

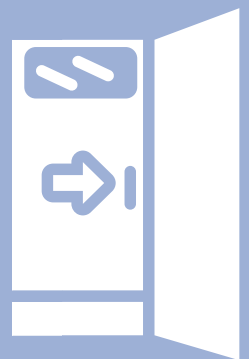

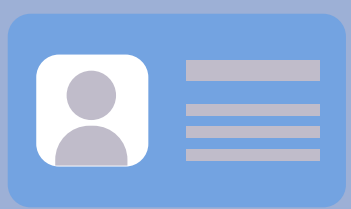

Fire Safety

Something you didn't Know

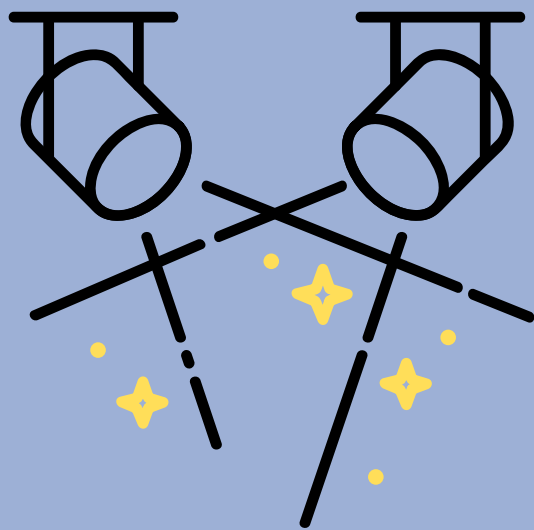
The Undergraduate Halls was commissioned in March 2002 and was named as Hall A, B, C and D.

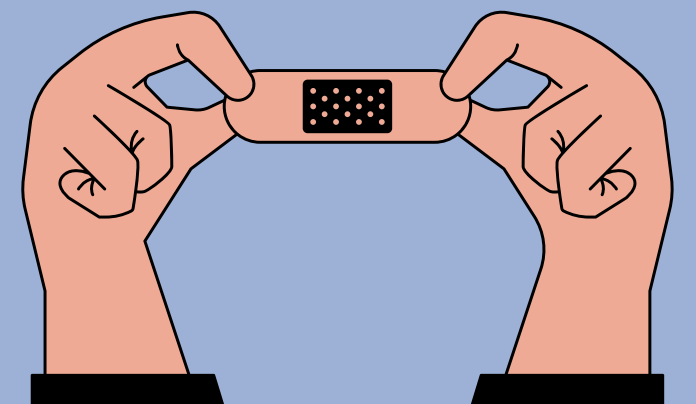
