#### Entrance Scholarship

#### 藝術及科技文理學士(榮譽)入學獎學金

### 1. Background

The Bachelor of Arts and Science (Hons) in Arts and Technology [BASc(ARTT)] (JUPAS Catalogue No.: JS2920), hosted by the School of Creative Arts (SCA), is a newly-established UGC undergraduate programme that was launched in 2022/23.

The Programme recognizes the importance of knowledge and culture exchange among students with different backgrounds. In order to encourage potential local and non-local students to enroll into the Programme, the BASc(ARTT) Entrance Scholarship for local and non-local students will be offered.

### 2. Provision of the Scholarship

- (a) Up to ten one-off scholarships of HKD 20,000, funded by the School of Creative Arts, will be offered for 2023/24.
- (b) Successful candidates are NOT allowed to hold concurrent scholarships granted by HKBU.

### 3. Eligibility Criteria

- (a) For students who are admitted to the Programme through Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS) or Non-JUPAS, they must join the selection interview of the Bachelor of Arts and Science (Hons) in Arts and Technology.

### 4. Selection Criteria

- (a) Full-time local or non-local students who have outstanding performance during the admission interview with at least 80% of the total interview marks;
- (b) Candidates should demonstrate excellent communication skills and professionalism with great passion in studying the Programme during the interview;
- (c) The portfolios created by candidates are of high quality (if applicable); and
- (d) Candidates have a track record of participating in extra-curricular activities.

### 5. Selection Procedures

- (a) Full-time local or non-local students who are admitted to the Programme and have fulfilled the eligibility and selection criteria will be considered for the Scholarship.
- (b) The selection is conducted and approved by the Programme.
- (c) Award notification emails will be sent to the awardees in batches according to the difference on the admission timelines of JUPAS and non-JUPAS. The non-JUPAS awardees will be notified in March-August while JUPAS awardees will be notified in

August-September. All awardees will be asked to sign an acceptance undertaking form.

**6. Conditions of Award**

- (a) The Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient ceases to be a student of the Programme. The recipients are required to return the awarded Scholarship upon their withdrawal from the Programme at any stage of his/her study.
- (b) If none of the candidates meet the eligibility and selection criteria in the academic year, the award will not be offered.
- (c) Recipient of the Scholarship is required to attend functions related to the Scholarship organized by the Programme.
- (d) The Programme reserves the right to make the final decision as to the list of recipients.
- (e) HKBU reserves the right to deduct the Scholarship from the student's outstanding University Fees if any.

**7. Handling of Information and Personal Data Supplied in Application (for Regulations and Procedures only)**

- (a) The personal data provided in this nomination will be used for activities relating to the processing of the nomination for the Scholarship award and the compilation of the relevant statistics to facilitate review of the award.
- (b) The personal data provided in the application / nomination forms will only be disclosed to relevant parties for the purposes mentioned in the preceding paragraph above.
- (c) The candidates have the right to request the correction of and to request access to the data provided.
